About the racing

Round robin match sprinting, each rider will get at least three match sprints to accumulate points towards the daily finals, where riders race off per grade for the day. An aggregate applies with points for wins for the day and the series. A grade to C grade. Grading is based on flying 200 times, and flying 200 times are used in countbacks in the case of tied points (sandbag at your own risk!). Grading is based on flying 200 performance only, not gender or age.

- Entry fee \$10, all riders must have a current CA licence – NO DAY LICENCES WILL BE ISSUED
- Entries open at 11:30am on race day only. Entries capped at 30 riders per day. Entries close at 12:30 or when 30 riders have entered, whichever comes first
- Series entries are available, conditions apply, please enquire for details
- Qualifying Flying 200's start at 12, match sprints start at 1pm. Racing is expected to be finished by 5:30pm
- Races are 2 laps of Blackburn's 307m track, finals for first and second place are 3 laps
